

Virtual Education Tuition Agreement

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 121.78(1), the School District of Waukesha (“the District”) and the Resident District hereby agree as follows:

1. Attendance

The District agrees to permit the Student to take a full course load at eAchieve Academy during the 2019-2020 school year. The student will be enrolled full-time at the Resident district. The District agrees to provide the following services:

- Virtual instruction, feedback, and assessment provided by Wisconsin-certified teachers who are licensed in the content area according to DPI guidelines for NCLB implementation
- Student access to the learning management system and email account
- Observer access to the learning management system
- Student access to teachers via email, phone, and/or the online lecture environment
- Orientation materials and training for the student and observers
- Progress updates provide to parent/guardian and monitor at school of full-time enrollment
- End of course grade report
- Transcript upon request

2. Tuition

The Resident district agrees to pay the District tuition in the amount of \$_____, an amount calculated in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 121.78(1) and § 118.51(16)(a)3. This amount is equal to the current non-special education open enrollment transfer amount. Invoicing will occur within 30 days of October 1 and March 1 for each semester, respectively. Payment by the Resident district shall be made within 30 days of the invoice. If the Student withdraws from the eAchieve Academy during the school year, the tuition amount will be prorated according to the number of days the Student was enrolled.

Note: Any student with a remaining balance in the previous semester may be prevented from participating in the following semester until the balance is paid in full.

3. Resident District Obligations

The Resident district agrees and understands it will be the Local Education Agency responsible for Free Appropriate Public Education (“FAPE”) and the responsibilities that

come along with such. The act of paying tuition or having a contract with the District does not transfer accountability.

Accordingly, the Resident district agrees to the following obligations:

- Special Education Testing and Services
- Proctoring and Reporting of any state-mandated testing
- The diploma upon satisfying the Resident district's graduation requirements
- All other FAPE responsibilities and obligations

The parties agree there are no other responsibilities or obligations by the parties, unless expressed otherwise.

4. Termination of Enrollment

In accordance with Wis. Stat. § 118.40, the District may terminate the Student's open enrollment if the Student fails to participate. The decision to terminate the Student's enrollment will be outlined in a notification to the Student's parent/guardian, the Resident District, and DPI.

The parties to this Agreement state that they have carefully read this Agreement, know and understand its contents, had the opportunity to retain and confer with legal counsel regarding the terms, conditions, and consequences of this Agreement, have the full and complete authority to execute this Agreement, and freely enter into the Agreement in accordance with the provisions of Wisconsin Statute Section 121.78(1).
